


# **PROJECT LOCATION**

- Multi-leg intersection with residential land use
- Moore Catholic High School and PS 60, The Alice Austin School 3 blocks north of intersection
- S62, S92 and X11 buses on Victory Blvd
- NYCT request for bus stop improvements



# SAFETY DATA


- 7 injuries (2012-16)
  - 3 pedestrian, 4 motor vehicle
- 100% of pedestrians were hit when crossing with the signal
- Victory Blvd is a Vision Zero Priority Corridor



#### **EXISTING CONDITIONS & ISSUES**

Eliminate existing channelization and restore parking on Victory Blvd (+ 9 spaces)

Construct concrete sidewalk / bus stop

### **PROPOSAL DETAILS**

concrete island, based on community Arlene feedback S Sideview Ave | $\sim$ Victory Blvd 12 Maintain space for Maintain existing vehicles continuing "curb line" for straight on WB Victory new bus stop Blvd to maneuver safely around vehicles waiting to turn to SB Arlene St BUSSIOP

Narrowed proposed

#### **BENEFITS OF PROPOSAL**

- Shortens crossing distances for pedestrians
- New sidewalk provides safe place to wait for transit riders and makes bus stop safe and accessible
- Upgraded markings clarify vehicle movements and restore parking spaces on Victory Blvd
