The Westchester Square BID was established in 2012 to:


- Provide resources for businesses



Vision Zero and Crash History

- There have been 33 crashes at the intersection of Westchester Ave and E Tremont Ave. between 2010-2014
- 3 persons were severely injured; 1 person was killed
- E Tremont Ave is a Vision Zero Priority Corridor
- DOT installed refuge islands, 2015







LOCAL TRUCK ROUTES




TRAFFIC DATA - AM PEAK HOUR

- New Plaza rules have recently been passed and are part of the Administrative Code.
- With every new Plaza we install rules signage

Welcome! We want you to have a safe and enjoyable time. Be courteous and respectful to others, and please keep the plaza clean.

Pedestrian Plaza Rules Prohibit:

- Obstruction of pedestrian traffic
- Destruction, removal or tampering of any property or equipment
- Camping
- Unattended property
- A person or their belongings taking up more than one seat
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages, except as otherwise permitted
- Skateboarding, except as otherwise permitted
- Feeding of undomesticated animals
- Spitting, urination, defecation
- Unreasonable noise
- Dogs off-leash



Permits are required for all events

Bicycle riding is only permitted on designated routes or where indicated by signage or markings
