**NYC DOT will implement Vision Zero safety improvements along White Plains Rd. from Burke Ave. to E. 216th St.:**

- Install curbside parking protected bike lane in both directions
- Install painted pedestrian islands on White Plains Rd. between Burke Ave. to E. 216th St.
- Install new signal and crosswalks to create safer, shorter crossings at E. 211th St.
- Install commercial loading zones at select locations on White Plains Rd.

**Implementation begins May 2022**
