FDNY MEDAL DAY 2023 INFORMATION

2.1.1 FDNY MEDAL DAY

The Fire Department's Presentation of Medals Ceremony will be held on **Wednesday, June 7, 2023, at 1100 hours**. The ceremony will take place at the Louis Armstrong Stadium at 124-02 Roosevelt Avenue, Queens, NY. Medal Recipients can be dropped off at the parking lot entrance on Meridian Road near the West side of the stadium. They will enter the stadium through Gate A on the West side of the Louis Armstrong Stadium. There will be a check-in area in the vicinity of this entrance. Guests will enter through the East Gate and be seated in sections 112 through 116. The East Gate can be reached via the Flushing Meadows Pedestrian Bridge from the Citi Field parking lots or the LIRR Willets Point Station.

2.1.2 FDNY MEDAL DAY – SECURITY RESTRICTIONS

Everyone attending the Medal Day 2023 ceremony will be required to pass through a metal detector and show FDNY Identification (Including those in uniform).

2.1.3 FDNY MEDAL DAY – PARKING

Parking for personal cars will be available at Citi Field in Lot F. Attendees can then walk across the Flushing Meadows Pedestrian Bridge to the Louis Armstrong Stadium entrance. There will be Ceremonial Unit members at this location to assist.

2.1.4 FDNY MEDAL DAY – BUS DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

The designated bus drop-off and pick-up will be in Citi Field. Members can then walk across the Flushing Meadows Pedestrian Bridge to the Louis Armstrong Stadium entrance. There will be Ceremonial Unit members at this location to assist.

2.1.5 FDNY MEDAL DAY – BANNERS

Medal recipient's units wishing to display banners at the medal day ceremony are requested to deliver the banners (**no later than Friday June 2, 2023**) to:

The Ceremonial Unit will prominently display the banners for your unit. Banners which are not delivered to the Ceremonial Unit can be displayed, but NOT hung or attached to any part of the Stadium.

Please limit the size of the banners to 4'x 6'. This will help the Ceremonial Unit to display all the banners.

Additional reminder to all units: Air Horns are **NOT** permitted at the ceremony.
