SECOND REGIMENT

FIRST BATTALION

Comprised of Deputy Chiefs, Battalion Chiefs, Company Officers and Firefighters of the 11th, 13th, and 14th Divisions.

SECOND BATTALION

Comprised of Deputy Chiefs, Battalion Chiefs, Company Officers and Firefighters of the 8th and 15th Divisions.

All members assigned to units indicated above shall remain in formation at the conclusion of the service. Their Commanding Officers and Control Officers participating in the formal review shall guide them.

Members who wish to participate and who are not included in this Department Order, shall report to the Ceremonial Unit Officer on Riverside Drive, directly behind chairs, at 1015 hours for assignment.

The National Flag shall be displayed at half-staff on all Department buildings from 0800 hours to sunset, October 8, 2025.

At 1100 hours, Wednesday, October 8, 2025, Department apparatus in all Firehouses and EMS Stations shall be pulled onto the apron of quarters. The Dispatcher in charge of Central Office in all boroughs shall have announcement made on Voice Alarm, "The time is 1100 hours, marking the beginning of Annual Memorial Service." All Officers and members in quarters shall stand at attention for one minute in memory of their deceased comrades, except when an alarm is received to which they are assigned to respond.
