#### **ANNOUNCEMENT**

 Federal Emergency Management Agency Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps Now Available

On December 5, 2013 FEMA released Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) for New York City. This is the first step in the regulatory review process, which includes a public comment period followed by a statutory 90-day appeals period before the maps are adopted by the City as new Effective FIRMs. Members of the public can submit comments at www.nyc.gov/floodmaps.

The Preliminary FIRMs do not impact flood insurance rates, but they do depict areas that will require flood insurance in the near future when these maps become effective, expected in 2015.

#### • Local Law 96 Now in Effect

#### **REMINDER**

#### LL84 – Next Quarterly Deadline to Submit for 2012 reporting is February 1st

If you have not yet submitted your calendar year 2012 benchmarking report to the City:

- o Follow the guidance on your violation notice to pay the penalty to the Department of Buildings to dismiss the violation.
- o Submit your LL84 2012 report to the City via the <u>NYC LL84 2012 reporting link</u> before February 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid the possible issuance of additional violations with additional penalties.

### **ANNOUNCEMENT**

### LL84 — Updates for 2013 Aggregated Data Requests

- Pursuant with Local Law 84, Section 28-309.4.1, the Office of Long-Term Planning and Sustainability will not require building owners to utilize the Non-Residential Tenant Data Collection Form for 2013 consumption. The City strongly encourages building owners to request aggregated consumption data directly from their respective utility companies.
- National Grid is currently taking requests. For instructions on how to submit your data request to National Grid, please refer to LL84 – Energy Data Collection.
- Con Ed will begin accepting requests on February 15, 2014. Please refer to the <u>Con Ed Benchmarking</u> website for more information.
- o The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) will resume uploading of water consumption via Portfolio Manager's web services starting on or around February 10, 2014. Water reporting is required for those buildings which have had an Automatic Meter Reader installed for the entirety of 2013.
