Procurement Title: Supervised Pre-trial Release Services

Agency: Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ)

Procurement Description:

MOCJ is expanding the number of individuals who can be served by NYC's effective supervised release model to reduce the number of people incarcerated by identifying those who can be safely supervised in the community pending the resolution of their case. MOCJ will be seeking proposals for a provider for criminal court in each borough. MOCJ conservatively estimates roughly 1,200 people, citywide, participating in supervised release.

The selected vendors will be responsible for assessing the risk and needs of individual defendants, supervising release provides services, supervision and referrals to individuals awaiting trial, enabling better engagement with stabilizing programs and services while avoiding the costs and burdens of pre-trial detention. The vendors will target all persons appearing at arraignments who: Are likely to have bail set based on a review of charge characteristics and risk and do not present a significant risk of being re-arrested during the pretrial period.

Program activities include:

1. Screening: Identify and briefly screen appropriate clients after court calendar reviews and discussions with defense attorney.
2. Court Advocacy: Establish program eligibility and proposed service components to the court.
3. Intake and Assessment: Conduct an approved comprehensive assessment at program intake for each participant.
4. Supervision: Provide case management and supervision appropriate to the assessed risk and needs. Case management will include but is not limited to phone and personal contact and appropriate referrals.
5. Court Reporting: Attend all court appearances; manage/create reports as required by the court until the mandate is completed.
