## 1. Welcome/Introductions

#### 2. Presentation

NYC DOT representatives presented a proposal for intersection safety improvements on 116<sup>th</sup> Street, between Lenox and Fifth Avenues. There have been a number of injuries and fatalities at this intersection in the past several years. DOT has several recommendations to mitigate the safety concerns at this location, including:

- a) an extension of the median closer onto 116<sup>th</sup> Street (similar to medians on Adam Clayton Powell Blvd.); and
- b) prohibiting left hand turns from 116<sup>th</sup> Street onto Lenox Avenue and diverting traffic to adjacent avenues.

### 3. Actions

District Needs Statement: Three Top Issues

Main corridors: 110th to 125th, 125th through 145th. 145th through 155th.

- 1. Complete Streets Pedestrian / Bike / Vehicle Street Safety
- 2. Sanitation
  - Both on the train tracks and in streets
- 3. MTA NYC Transit Bus Service
  - Inefficiencies and lack of oversight for delayed buses and trains

- a) Muni Meters
  - How to best coordinate prior to installation of muni meters
  - How to communicate issues with the proposed muni meter locations
