I am writing to inform you that the NYC DOT is currently developing the first NYC Streets Plan in response to Local Law 195. The five-year plan seeks to improve the safety, accessibility, and quality of the City's streets for all New Yorkers. It will involve an in-depth analysis of the current planning efforts and will set equitable and ambitious goals for the City's streets.

NYC DOT aims to equitably engage as many NYC residents as possible, including constituents from (District/community name)__.
