ADMINISTRATION FOR CHILDREN'S SERVICES PAYMENT BULLETIN – Guide to Foster Care Special Payments-JULY 2013

FAMILY FOSTER CARE Section 1	Items within the Special Payment Budget Allocation are provided ONLY for children in Family Foster Care (see Section 1, pages 2-8).
	The items listed in this section of the Bulletin are approved by NYS and ACS for purchase for children in care. Each Provider is responsible for deciding which items to purchase and for monitoring their annual Special Payment Budget Allocation. Providers are to ensure that purchases remain within the limit of the Budget Allocation.
	With the exception of Child Care outside of New York City, College/ University Room & Board, Funeral Expenses, and Sign Language Services, all expenditures for items listed in this section of the Bulletin are to be tracked against the Special Payment Budget Allocation.
RESIDENTIAL CARE ALL LEVELS Section 2	Residential Care programs at all levels may bill for the following two Special Payment items ONLY. These items are outside of the Special Payment Budget Allocation. (See Section 2, page 9): College / University Room & Board Funeral Expenses
INVOICE DUE DATE	1. Invoices for actual expenses incurred in any one month shall be submitted to ACS by the Contractor within thirty (30) days after the end of each month in which such expenses were incurred. If the Contractor fails to provide ACS with the required invoices for the amounts incurred sixty (60) days after the date invoices are due and/or if the Contractor fails to provide invoices in a manner acceptable to ACS in accordance with this Fiscal Manual sixty (60) days after the date invoices are due, ACS, may, at its sole option, disallow such invoices.
	2. In the event that ACS deems it necessary to request additional documentation from the Contractor in order to complete payment processing, ACS will send a request to the Contractor. Requested documentation must be received by ACS no later than thirty (30) days from the date of the ACS request. If the Contractor fails to provide ACS with the requested documentation within the timeframe provided, ACS may at its sole option, disallow such invoices.
	3. If the Contractor invoices ACS for non-allowable expenses, ACS, may, without any prior notice to the Contractor, disallow such amounts from the Contractor's invoice(s) and pay the remaining allowable expense amounts, if any.
