COMMISSION DIRECTIVE: BROKER FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Dear Registrant:

All trade waste brokers currently registered by the Business Integrity Commission (the "Commission") are required to submit annual financial statements to the Commission. All financial statements must be submitted to the Commission *on or before June 30, 2022*. The form for the 2021 financial statements is available on the Commission's website: <u>http://www.nyc.gov/bic</u>.

All submissions of 2021 financial statements, extension requests, or exemption requests must be submitted through the <u>BIC Online Portal</u>. This portal is on the BIC website, the same location where the Vehicle module and Customer Register module are found.

All requests for an exemption from the annual submission requirement must be submitted through the portal *before May 26, 2022*. All requests for additional time to submit financial statements must be made *no later than June 16, 2022*. YOU MUST RESPOND TO THIS DIRECTIVE. Your failure to respond to this Commission Directive to submit financial statements will be considered to be violations of Title 17, Chapter 1, Subchapter F of the Rules of the City of New York Sections 1-04(a), 6-04(f)(1) and 6-04(g), and could result in civil penalties of up to \$10,000 for each violation.
