On September 8, the NYC Board of Correction voted to APPROVE/RENEW/DENY the Department of Correction's request for a limited variance from BOC Minimum Standard 1-17(d)(2) regarding punitive segregation.

Pursuant to §1-15(b)(1)(i) of the New York City Board of Correction's ("Board") minimum standards, the New York City Department of Correction ("Department") requests a limited variance to §1-17(d)(2) and the second sentence of §1-17(d)(1)1 of the Board's Minimum Standards (Punitive Segregation) to allow the Department, in highly exceptional circumstances presenting safety and security concerns, to waive the requirement that inmates be immediately released from punitive segregation for seven (7) days after they have been held in punitive segregation for thirty (30) consecutive days.
