Review of a new on-premises liquor license application submitted to the State Liquor Authority on behalf of 381 7th Avenue Wine Bar LLC at 381 7th Avenue (between 11th/12th Streets).

381 7th Avenue – Brookvin Wine Bar. Brian Reed is purchasing existing business from the owners. It will be a full liquor license.

The backyard has 24 seats with fencing, shrubs and umbrellas and provides actual table service. An adjacent neighbor complains about backyard noise – too loud and has had to move bedrooms away from the back of the house. Sound reduction is recommended by several committee members.

Regina Myers moves to approve with the understanding that applicant and neighbors will work to improve conditions. Eric Anderson seconded.

Pauline Blake offers a friendly amendment to add sound attenuation. Regina declined to accept.

Joe Porcelli offers a friendly amendment to limit outside seating to 24 seats not 42. Several committee members expressed concern about backyard noise. Joe Porcelli called the question.
