Continued review of a Certificate of Appropriateness application submitted to the Landmarks Preservation Commission for the replacement of a 2-story rear yard extension, addition of a partial new story and new roof decks at 929 President Street (between 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Prospect Park West), Park Slope Historic District.

A motion was made for conditional approval with the following conditions.

- Rear addition no planters
- Roof top addition
  - 1. Not visible from the street and moved back so not visible
  - 2. No upper railing
  - 3. Less glass
- No planter in front retain railings
- All railings vertical
- Starkly modern style is not in keeping with historic block
