**\*\*\*MINUTES\*\*\***

The meeting was called to order at 6:45PM and a motion was made to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting held on September 15, 2011. There were 11 committee members in attendance.

**Presentation and discussion with representatives for the Department of Transportation on the new BikeShare program where thousands of bicycles will become available to the public at self-service docking stations throughout the City.**

**Representatives from the Department of Transportation including Chris Hrones, John Walcott and Kate Fillin-Yeh to discuss the program and BikeShare station siting guidelines.**

The Department of Transportation will oversee maintenance of bike area, snow removal, graffiti and bike function.

- Annual pass will be \$90-\$95 unlimited, day pass \$8-\$10, weekly pass \$20-\$25
- 45 minute use without extra cost – trips longer than that will incur a fee.
- Credit card payment
- Areas chosen in conjunction with the Transportation stations.
- Station density dictates the size of the bike kiosks.
- Bike kiosk – modular system, solar powered, wireless – can be installed/removed within an hour with no structural damage.

- The system exists in other cities. We are not the first city.
- GPS bike tag and each bike has a serial number for identification.

OTHER BUSINESS: The committee discussed other topics to be considered for future meetings.

- Commuter vans (dollar vans)
- Invite 78<sup>th</sup> Precinct to review alternate side parking. Reduce time to 90 minutes.
- Truck routes
- Ice cream/yogurt trucks parking in bike lanes/cars
- NYPD to advise their patrols of rules etc.
- Feedback on pilot program on parking meters
- Downtown traffic pr
- 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> Avenue area-infrastructure to curb speeding
- Bollard by each school
- Update on DOT traffic calming
- Truck routes – reconstruction of Van Brunt/Columbia Streets.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned.
