Unit is comprised of hermetically-sealed compressor, air-cooled condenser, evaporator coil with direct drive blower, expansion valve and safety controls. Terms and Conditions: The above-described packaged air conditioner units are accepted for outdoor installation, under the following conditions:

- 1. Units shall use only Refrigerant R-22.
- 2. All equipment shall be furnished with a permanently affixed metal tag stating that if installed in New York City within 100 feet of any dwelling unit window, there shall be compliance with all provisions of Section 27-770, subdivision 4, as to maximum sound levels permitted for exterior mechanical equipment.
- 3. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Board before installation.
- 4. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- 5. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
