

Request for Code Revision Technical & Advisory Committee Participants

The Department of Buildings is requesting applications from members of the construction, real estate, labor, architectural, and engineering community, and other interested stakeholders, to serve on technical and advisory committees that will help develop and review amendments to the 2014 New York City Construction Codes as part of the mandated three year code revision cycle. Applications will be accepted through **March 30, 2017**.

NOTE: The application deadline has been extended through APRIL 14, 2017.

Additionally, it is the intention of the Department to develop a code that specifically addresses alterations to existing buildings (a.k.a. the Existing Building Code). The Department has engaged the services of the International Code Council to assist with research and development of the first draft of existing building code provisions. It is the Department's intention to submit the draft of the NYC Existing Building Code to the NYC Construction Codes Committees during this revision cycle.

BACKGROUND

The New York City Construction Codes consist of five technical volumes – the New York City Building Code (BC), Energy Conservation Code (ECC), Plumbing Code (PC), Mechanical Code (MC), and the Fuel Gas Code (FGC) – and one administrative volume – the Administrative Code (Title 28), which contains permitting, licensing, fees, and other provisions that apply universally to the five technical volumes. It should be noted that the NYC Energy conservation code was recently updated by Local Law 125 of 2016 and therefore will not be reviewed as part of this Construction Codes revision effort.

Every three years, the New York City Construction Codes must be updated based upon the latest version of the International Code Council Codes (I-Codes). To this end, the Department is organizing a series of committees to review changes made in the 2015 I-Codes and determine how and if these changes should be incorporated into the New York City Construction Codes. The Department expects to begin submitting the proposed Code Revisions to the New York City Council in 2018.

TIME COMMITMENT

Advisory and technical committees meet on a regular basis. Committee members are expected to be available to attend all meetings of their committee. All committee work is on a volunteer basis. The Department cannot provide any compensation for work or travel.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

Committee participants should be "experts" in the subject matter considered by the respective committee. Members may represent either a specific organization, or be appointed to act on their own behalf due to their personal expertise in the subject matter.

Organizations whose interest is primarily in the areas of real estate, labor, policy, or economics, and who wish to have representation on a technical or advisory committee, must provide a technical expert to represent their organization. The Department will not consider applications for individuals who do not possess technical proficiency in regards to the material assigned to the committee.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

Space on the technical and advisory committees identified below is limited. The Department seeks to appoint volunteers to committees to ensure a balanced representation of stakeholders.
