### **Cash Payment Restrictions**

# Effective April 10, 2017, the New York City Department of Buildings will limit cash payments to a maximum of \$50.00 per transaction. Additionally, the Department will not accept cash payments for civil penalties or returned checks (A.K.A. 'No Good Checks').

Acceptable methods of payment for application/filing fees are

- Credit Cards\* (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express)
- Personal Checks
- Company Checks
- Money Orders
- Cash (maximum \$50.00 per transaction)

#### Acceptable methods of payment for online transactions

- e-Checks
- Credit Cards\* (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express)

#### Acceptable methods of in-person payment for Civil Penalties

- Certified Checks
- Bank or Cashiers' Checks
- Money Orders
- Credit Cards

#### Acceptable methods of in-person payment for return checks

- Certified Checks
- Bank or Cashiers' Checks
- Money Orders

#### Payment Requirement for Credit Cards

 A valid photo ID is required, example: DOB-issued ID, valid driver's license, valid passport, or a NYC-issued ID (iDNYC)

NOTE: Credit card charges carry a 2.49% convenience fee, which is assessed on the total payment amount due. The convenience fee is required by the third-party provider and is non-refundable.
