New York City Construction Codes Revision Committee: Accepting Applications for Members

The Department is seeking applicants to serve on the 2017 Construction Codes Revision & Development Committee. To be considered for committee membership, a completed application must be signed and submitted, including all required documentation, to the Department by March 30, 2017. The application deadline has been extended through APRIL 14, 2017.

The NYC Construction Codes revision process will consist of eight Technical Committees and five Advisory committees. Members of these committees would be responsible for reviewing and drafting Code revisions. The Department encourages interested stakeholders, members of the architectural, construction, engineering, labor, and real estate communities to apply. - Applicants must submit a current résumé and government-issued photo identification with their completed application.

Applicants are directed to indicate which committee(s) they wish to serve on. In order to serve committee members are expected to:

- Possess subject matter expertise in the content of an assigned committee
- Be available to meet on a regular basis, and complete their assigned tasks
- Comply with the terms described in the 2017 Construction Codes Revision Cycle Handbook.
