SUBJECT: Rules and Regulations for Power Operated Cranes, Derricks
and Cableways

In order to implement the on-site inspection requirements of the above rules and regulations which are effective as of October 17, 1969, the following instructions should be given to all Construction Inspectors:

(1) Construction Inspectors to submit a report to borough superintendent indicating construction sites where a crane or derrick is in operation. Report to also indicate hoisting and rigging section inspection number.

(2) Construction Inspector to inspect foundation of all cranes on sites. Any questions as to condition of foundation should be immediately reported to borough superintendent.

(3) Inspectors are to check for a valid "Certificate of Inspection" from the department and for license of crane operator. Where a crane does not have a valid certificate, or operator does not have a license, Inspector is to notify Jack Grill at 566-0339; or George Durkin at 566-4433; or if these personnel are not available call Julius Schneider, Director of Special Projects at 566-2480.

In order for the Crane and Derrick section to keep track of the Cranes and Derricks through out the City a copy of the Inspectors report on "Location of Cranes to the Borough Superintendent" should be sent to Jack Grill at 2 Lafayette Street.
