Revision to C 26-35.0 of the Building Code - Crane on-site inspection and fees as described in Local Law 50/73.

On Soptember 21, 1973 the Mayor signed Local Law 50/73 which became effoctive intediately. Copies of the new legislation are forwarded herewith. The following procedures shall be effective upon filing hereafter of building notice applications for crame on-site inspections ( Form 21 C ).

- I) Ordans with boom longths, including jibs and extensions thereof, which ard less than 250 feet:
  - 1.) Fee remains \$25.00
- II) Or was with boom lengths, including jibs and extensions thereof, which are 250 fact and longer and which are inspected during the no wal work week:
  - 1.) Fee increased to 350.00
  - 2.) Plan extrainer shall notify the applicant that approval of the at we noted machines by Grane and Derrick Division is required. This shall be noted on an Objection sheet. Crane and Derrick Division will chick fee and note on the examiners objection sheet whether an appointment has been made for the inspection of the crame. If appointment is ma > the plan examiner shall continue to examine the building notice ap lication for on-site inspection.

The Grame and Derrick Division will notify the chief construction in postor of the borough involved of the scheduled crane inspection and the chief construction inspector shall schedule an on-site inspection in conjunction with the crane division.

- III) Common with boom longths, including jibs and extensions thereof, which are 250 fest and longer and which are to be inspected by the Of me and Derrick Division on days other than the normal work week ( Troumdays, Sundays and holidays ):

  - 1. Per increased to 1100.03
    2. Rich examiner shall notify the applicant that approval of the shove noted machines by Grane and Derrick Division is required. This shall be noted on an Objection sheet. Crame and Derrick Division will check fee and note on the examiners objection sheet whether an appointment has been made for the inspection of the crane. If appointment is made the plan examinar shall continue to examine the building notice application for on-site inspection.
