Local Law 196 of 2017: New Form Created to Certify Correction for Summonses Issued for Failing to Comply with Site Safety Training Requirements

Effective November 13, 2018, the new <u>AEU3321</u> form must be used to certify the correction of summonses issued for failing to comply with safety training requirements mandated by the New York City Building Code (BC) <u>Section 3321.1 and/or Section 3321.2</u>.

The new <u>AEU3321</u> form combines the <u>AEU2</u> (Certificate of Correction) and the <u>AEU20</u> (Statement in Support) to streamline the Certificate of Correction application process. The new form must be submitted to the Department's Administrative Enforcement Unit and will be the **only** form accepted to correct site safety training summonses. The standard <u>AEU2</u> and <u>AEU20</u> forms must be used to certify correction of summonses issued for failing to comply with the log requirements set forth in BC Section 3321.2 items 3 and 4.

Named respondents, property owners and DOB-issued ID holders can receive same-day service, for a maximum of two Certificates of Correction per person, Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 2:30pm. However, the Administrative Enforcement Unit will not limit the number of in-person form submissions for a particular job site to establish its compliance with site safety training requirements. In instances where a submission exceeds the allowable two Certificate of Correction applications, the submitter will be notified when the review is complete. Documents can also be submitted by mail.
