The plaintiffs City of New York ("City") and Lorelei Salas, as Commissioner of the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs ("DCA") and the defendants Crum & Forster Insurance Brokers, Inc. ("Crum") and Williams National Surety Corp. ("Williams") duly made application to this Court for an Order pursuant to New York City Administrative Code ("Code") § 20-704 approving their settlement (the "Settlement") of the above-captioned matter as to Crum and Williams.

Upon reading and filing the affirmation of Glenna Goldis, counsel to the plaintiffs, and the Settlement, and after due deliberation having been had thereon,

NOW, on motion of the City, DCA, Crum, and Williams, this Court:

APPROVES the Settlement pursuant to Code § 20-704.


ORDERS that DCA shall notify potential claimants of the Settlement using the following language (the "Notice"):

"This year the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) sued the bail bond agent Marvin Morgan and various other parties, including Crum & Forster Insurance Brokers, Inc., Evergreen National Indemnity Company, and Williams National Surety Corp. DCA recently settled some of its claims related to Morgan's conduct. If you believe you were harmed by Morgan and want to participate in the settlement, please contact DCA by calling 311 or visiting nyc.gov/dca as soon as possible, but no later than July 15, 2020."

ORDERS that plaintiffs shall provide the Notice by:

1. Publishing the Notice on DCA's website for ninety days;
2. Publishing the Notice on DCA's social media accounts;
3. Causing the Notice to be published in the City Record; and
4. Conducting outreach to entities that serve affected communities
