Subject: Notice of a public hearing to consider a proposal to classify new non-competitive class titles for the Queens County District Attorney [904].

The Commissioner of the Department of Citywide Administrative Services has scheduled a public hearing to be held on March 27th, 2019, 10:00 AM, Spector Hall, 22 Reade Street, New York, NY 10007. This hearing will consider a proposal to classify eight new managerial titles, and the non-managerial title of Supervising Accountant Investigator (Rackets) in the non-competitive class, for the use of the Queens County District Attorney [904].
