Subject: Notice of a Public Hearing on a proposal to amend the classification of the Classified Service of the City of New York under the heading DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION (846) by including 6 new managerial titles in the Non-Competitive class.

The Deputy Commissioner of Human Capital, Department of Citywide Administrative Services has scheduled a Public Hearing to be held on February 14, 2018, at 10:00 AM, 125 Worth Street, 2nd Floor Auditorium, New York, NY 10013 on a proposal to amend the classification of the Classified Service of the City of New York.

We propose to classify the following managerial titles, in the Non-Competitive Class, subject to Rule X, Part I:

MXXXXX	Borough Commissioner (Parks and Recreation)	(5 positions)
MXXXXX	Borough Director of Recreation (Parks and Recreation)	(6 positions)
MXXXXX	Deputy Borough Commissioner (Parks and Recreation)	(7 positions)
MXXXXX	Deputy Chief of Operations (Parks and Recreation)	(12 positions)
MXXXXX	Director of Neighborhood Restoration Program	(13 positions)

Part I positions are designated as confidential or policy influencing under Rule 3.2.3 (b) of the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of New York and therefore are not covered by Section 75 of the Civil Service Law.

We propose to classify the following managerial title, in the Non-Competitive Class, subject to Rule X, Part II:

MXXXXX Director or Regional Joint Interest Park (48 positions)
(Parks and Recreation)

Part II positions are covered by Section 75 of the Civil Service Law Disciplinary procedures after 5 years of service.

Management classes of positions are paid in accordance with the Pay Plan for Management Employees. Salaries for these positions are set at a rate in accordance with duties and responsibilities (PPME).
