Subject: Notice of a Public Hearing on a proposal to amend the Classification of the Classified Service of the City of New York under the heading of NEW YORK CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (009), by classifying new titles in the Non-Competitive class.

The Deputy Commissioner of Human Capital, Department of Citywide Administrative Services has scheduled a Public Hearing to be held on March 14, 2018, at 10:00 AM, at 22 Reade Street, Spector Hall, New York, NY 10007 on a proposal to amend the Classified Service of the City of New York.

We propose to classify the following managerial titles in the Non-Competitive Class, subject to Rule X, Part I, as follows:

MXXXXX	Deputy Director of Finance (NYCERS)	(1 Position)
MXXXXX	Deputy Director of Operations (NYCERS)	(1 Position)

Management classes of positions are paid in accordance with the Pay Plan for Management Employees. Salaries for these positions are set at a rate in accordance with duties and responsibilities (PPME).

Part I positions are designated as confidential or policy influencing under Rule 3.2.3 (b) of the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of New York and therefore are not covered by Section 75 of the Civil Service Law.
