## Statement of Basis and Purpose of Rule

On December 23, 2011 Governor Cuomo signed into law hapter 602 of the Laws of 2011, and on February 17, 2012, the previous statute. This legislation allows New York City to issue up to 18,000 transferable licenses to for-hire vehicles authorizing them to pick up passengers by street hail anywhere outside Manhattan (except for the airports) and in Street. Up to 6,000 of these licenses for Street Hail Liveries can be issued in the first year of the program. Twenty percent of these licenses will be set aside for wheelchair accessible
vehicles. As provided in the legislation, the TLC will make grants totaling up to $\$ 54$ million available for SHL lice
who plan to purchase, or upfit, a vehicle for use as an Accessible Street Hail Livery.
As it moves forward to implement the program provided for in the legislation, the TLC has adopted rules that will govern the grant program. These rules provide that

- Grants will be limited to $\$ 15,000$ Grants can be used to purchase an accessible vehicle for use as a street hail livery or have a vehicle
Vehicles can be no more th
- Vehicles can be no more than three years old and - The vehicle must be:
- A pre-approved purpose-built accessible

These rules are authorized by Section 2303 of the Charter and Section 19-503 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York as well as the enabling legislation.
