



DEDICATION PLAQUES

There shall be in all new buildings and major additions, except storage buildings, gatehouses and other minor structures, a dedication plaque commemorating the design and construction of the facility. At the discretion of the Commissioner of the Department of Design and Construction, the plaque shall include:

- The names and titles of the pertinent elected officials
- The name and title of the Commissioner or head of the agency sponsoring the project
- The name and title of the Commissioner of the Department of Design and Construction
- The name of the architectural firm responsible for the design.

Additionally, where the facility is operated and partially funded by a private or quasi-public institution, such as one of the library systems or major cultural institutions, additional names of the institution's Executive Director and Board Members may be included at the discretion of the Commissioner of the Department of Design and Construction. In most cases, the plaque shall be cast bronze with smooth raised letters and border, and pebble finish background.
