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Project Benefits


- New Watermains will improve water quality













Watermain Work












Sanitary and Storm Sewers combined and separated

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Encroachments

The City calls private improvements "encroachments" that do not lie within your property line.

- Currently we have six (6) encroachments in the work area that are pending.
- Each involve varying multiple fences and/or gates.

Working Hours During Construction



Scheduled Work Hours:

- Typical work hours are from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm, Monday to Friday
 - Potentially Noisy Work Operations
- Saturday work if necessary

Contractor will follow all DOT & Street Activity Permit Office Events as per OCMC stipulations.

Traffic Patterns During Construction





Contractors will maintain the following:



Personnel, signage and safe work site for pedestrians and vehicles.



Pedestrian access to buildings and sidewalks.



Keep a minimum width of 5 feet for access to sidewalks and crosswalks.



Maintain all local and emergency street access -

Traffic Patterns During Construction



Maintain one lane of traffic.

One travel lane to be kept on one-way intersecting streets.

Keep one travel lane in each direction on two-way intersecting streets.

Full roadway closure – intermittent and when necessary.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS & MITIGATIONS

Contractor shall:

- Work within DEP Noise Code Regulations.
- Post advance 24-Hour notice within impacted area.
- Keep storage site and MPT area clean & safe.
- Cover trucks delivering fill material.
- Professional rodent control inspector to monitor/maintain Rodent Control Stations.



COMMUNITY IMPACTS & MITIGATIONS (cont'd)

DDC will coordinate with MTA Surface regarding possible Bus Stop relocations – Bx29

Parking restrictions on Terrace St, Minnieford Ave, Bridge St and City Island Ave, as per DOT OCMC Permits; Signs will be posted in advance.

Driveway access may be temporarily restricted during work hours, but coordination is done case-by-case.

Garbage pick-up may be affected and will be coordinated with appropriate stakeholders.

Individuals with Special Needs should contact the CCL. DDC field staff will work to minimize inconveniences.



COMMUNITY OUTREACH

DCC's Office of Community Outreach + Notification (OCON), works with Community Boards, Business Improvement Districts, local businesses and other community stakeholders impacted by construction.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH (continued)

CCL responsibilities are as follows:

- First point of contact, maintain on-site presence and communication.
- Identify, resolve and/or proactively address issues and inquiries.
- Distribute advisory updates/weekly construction activities newsletter.
- Provide 72-hour and 24-hour (confirmation or cancellation) advisories for work impacts by email and door-to-door.
- Attend Community Board monthly DSC meetings to provide regular updates.




