**Water: A Precious Resource**

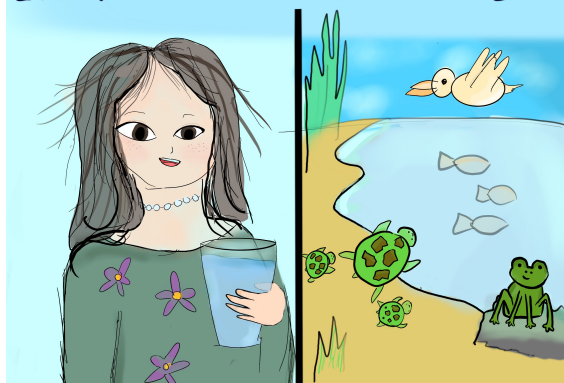
