Dear members of the Commission:

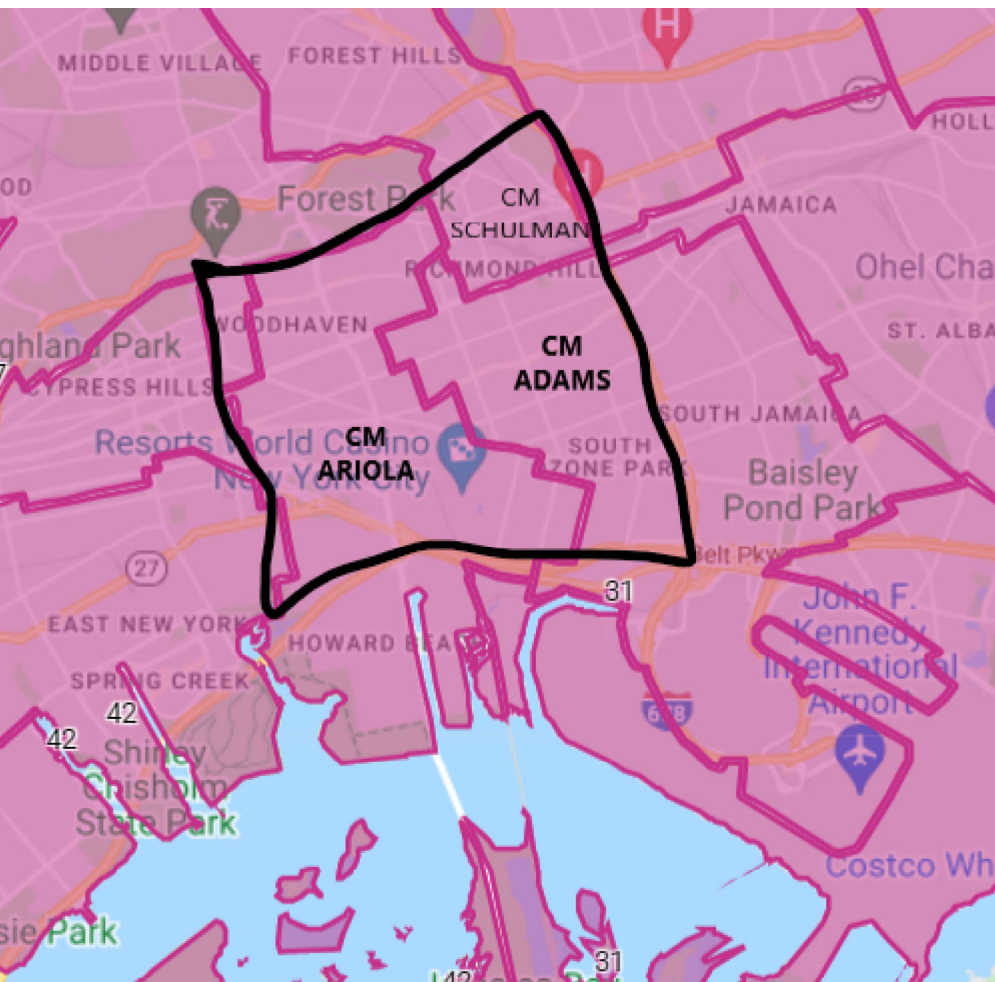
