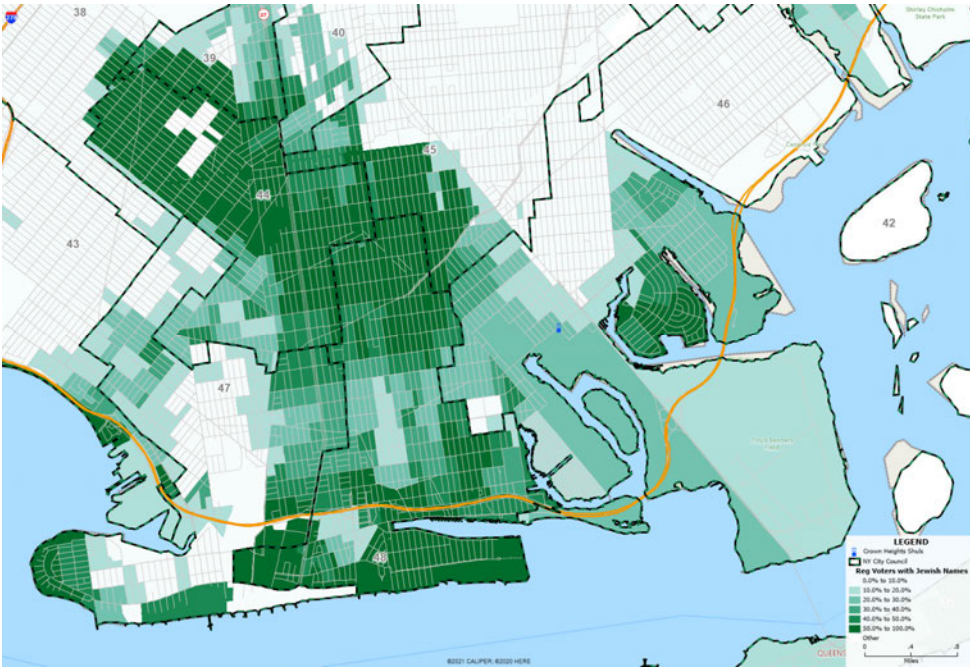
Attached are two PDF's reflecting the concentration of Jewish voters in Southern and Central Brooklyn.

These maps are based on data from PrimeNY and reflect the percentage of voters with distinctive Jewish names, i.e., in the deepest green districts over 50% of the voters have identifiable Jewish names. That translates to almost two-thirds of the actual voters being Jewish because many Jews do not have such names (e.g., Wice).

These numbers do not distinguish religiosity (Orthodox vs. Secular) and they include Russian-speakers.

I will leave it to the local advocates to determine where specific lines should be drawn, but please note:

1. Boro Park now extends to Ninth Avenue.
2. A considerable portion of Boro Park is now in the 39th.
3. A considerable portion of Orthodox Flatbush/Midwood south of Brooklyn College is currently in the 45th.
4. The concentration of Jewish voters extends to Avenue T.
