

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR VISITORS:



In order to keep everyone who works at, lives on, or visits Rikers Island and other city jails healthy, please stay home or postpone your visit if you are experiencing symptoms associated with coronavirus or the flu, including fever, coughing, or shortness of breath, or have recently traveled to a country with a CDC COVID-19 Travel Warning.

The New York City Department of Correction began screening visitors to Department facilities on Thursday March 12, 2020 in compliance with direction from the NY State Commission of Correction.

BEFORE YOU PLAN YOUR VISIT, PLEASE BE AWARE THAT:

- 1. Upon arrival to a DOC facility, you will be required to complete a visit screening form to identify potential risk factors for the coronavirus.
- 2. You may be required to provide a temperature reading.
- 3. You may be referred to an additional screening by an on-site licensed medical professional. In the event you have an elevated temperature, a medical professional may conduct an additional temperature reading.
- 4. If you are APPROVED for a visit, you will proceed through the regular security screening process
- 5. If you are NOT APPROVED for a visit by the medical professional, you will be provided a written determination and general written guidance that has been issued by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. However, you will not be permitted to proceed on your visit.

NOTE: You may choose to cancel your visit at any point during the screening process.
