

Members take part in productive activities that help the Clubhouse run. During lunch, the evening and weekends, members can participate in recreational activities. Members can participate in activities and get services in person, or by phone or videoconference. Members also choose what they do at the Clubhouse, when they go and how long they stay a member.

Clubhouse activities and services include:

- Help getting benefits, like affordable housing, health insurance and Supplemental Security Income.
- Health and legal services, like help getting no- or low-cost psychiatric and medical care, counseling, and legal help.
- Education services. Members get help applying for high school equivalency diploma classes, license trainings and college degree courses.
- Job services, like making a resume, and finding and applying for jobs. Clubhouses also offer members temporary work opportunities.
- Fun things to do with new people, like trips, game nights, and arts and crafts.
 Clubhouses are also open on holidays so members can celebrate with each other.
- Healthy meals and snacks. Members help buy, cook and serve food to other members.
