

Con Edison Utility Work at E. 10th Street between FDR Drive and Avenue D

Starting the week of May 2, 2022 **Ongoing until further notice**

Con Edison will begin phased upgrades of their utility lines under the ESCR project contract. Parking restrictions will be in effect during this operation and will be communicated through on-site signage. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times.



Utility work by Con Edison may include extended work hours and/or on weekends to facilitate utility relocation, maintenance work or inspection services.
