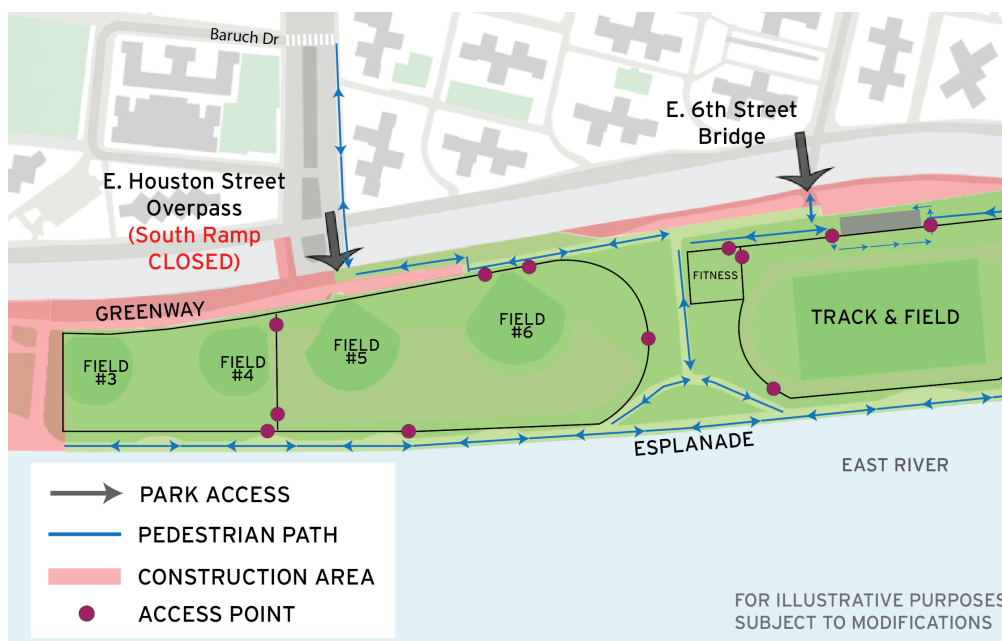
The East Side Coastal Resiliency (ESCR) Project is an initiative to provide long-term flood protection on the east side of Manhattan.

New Access Pattern for E. Houston St. Overpass at East River Park

Starting week of May 8th, 2023

Ongoing until further notice

Ongoing construction activity in East River Park will necessitate closure of the E. Houston St. south ramp, overpass south sidewalk and a portion of the Greenway. The north ramp will be opened for park access. Pedestrians use Baruch Dr. crosswalk for access. Park amenities will not be impacted. Please follow signage and the new access pattern shown below.
