

Utility Work at E. 10th Street between FDR Drive and Avenue D

Starting on February 9th, 2024 **Ongoing until further notice**

Phased upgrades of utility lines continue under the ESCR project contract. Parking restrictions and partial sidewalk closures will be in effect during this operation and will be communicated through on-site signage. Access to and from Jacob Riis Houses' Management Office will be maintained. One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times, including buses.



Utility work may include extended work hours and/or on weekends to facilitate utility relocation, maintenance work or inspection services
