Utility work by Con Edison may extend work hours and/or occur on weekends to facilitate utility relocations, maintenance work or inspection services.

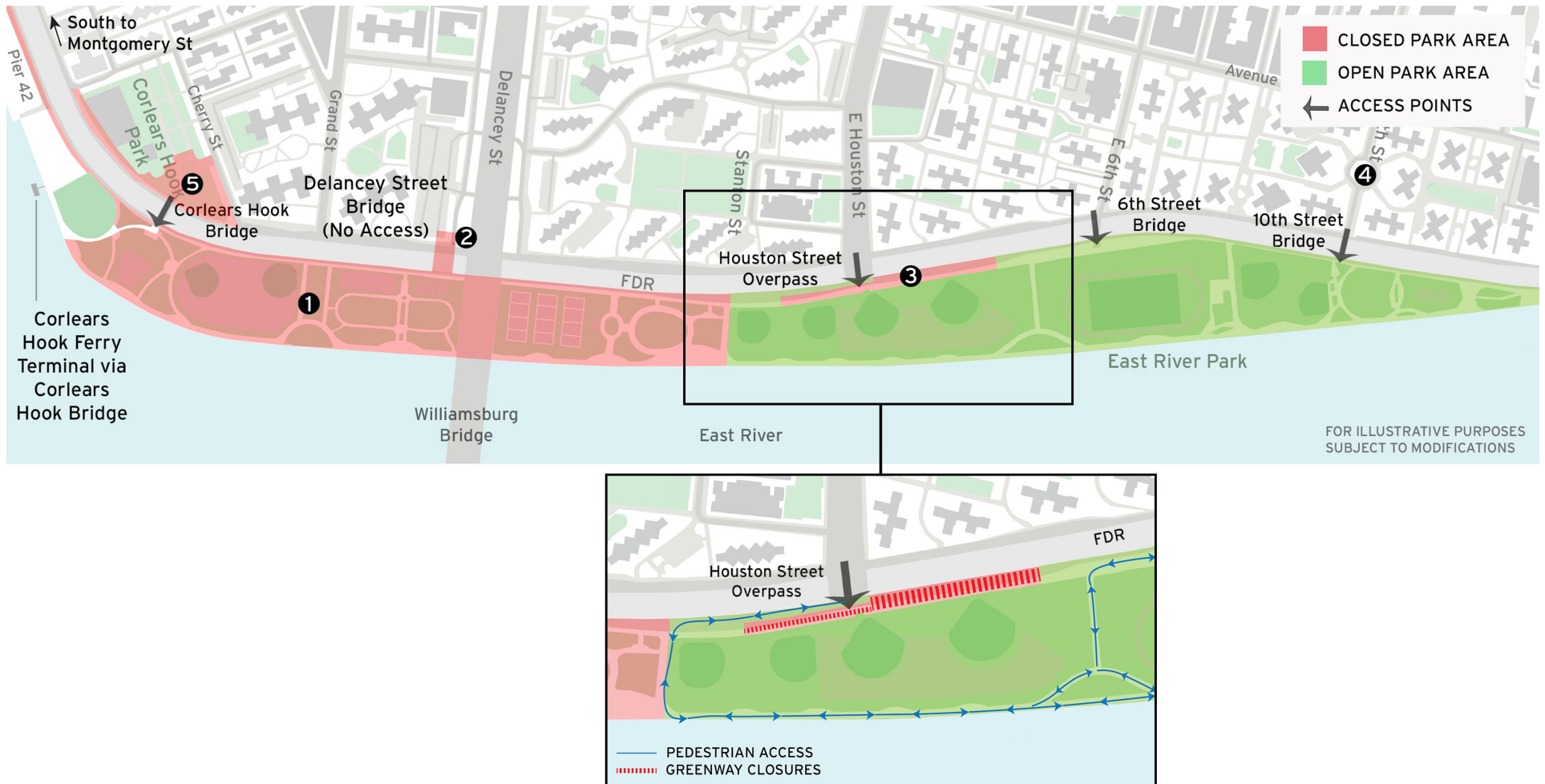
