

## Clients Meet with Employers at HRA Job Fair

On Friday, November 4, HRA's Business Link program brought 143 pre-screened HRA clients who have associates degrees or above to 123 Williams St. to meet with 63 employers from growth industries. HRA clients were given the opportunity to share their resumes and apply for over 1,000 available positions.

Before meeting with employers, clients attended an orientation which covered topics like interviewing skills, appropriate questions to ask at a job fair, self-presentation skills, and more to increase their chances of employment success.
