







• THERE WAS A RULING ON MONDAY ON THE BBJ!

- Judge Kelley's Decision in favor of NUBC and the rest of the Petitioners against the City annuls the City's resolution to build the Manhattan BBJ and he issued an injunction prohibiting any physical steps to effectuate construction of the Manhattan BBJ pending six conditions.
 - New Site Scoping sessions with Public Notice
 - Appropriate Public Comment Period
 - Amended DEIS, Traffic Impact Studies with Reasonable Alternatives to the Proposed Site
 - Appropriate Public Comment Period for the DEIS
 - Preparation and Circulation of an Amended FEIS
 - Preparation and Circulation of a NEW SEQRA Finding Statement
