NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

No. 1: IN THE MATTER of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval of a proposed amendment to the franchise agreement between the City of New York, by and through its Department of Transportation ("DOT") and JCDecaux Street Furniture New York, LLC, to install, operate, and maintain bus stop shelters, self-cleaning automatic public toilets, and public service structures and to install and maintain newsstands in the boroughs of the Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, and Staten Island. The proposed franchise agreement is requesting to extend the term of the Agreement by five years and incorporate additional rights and responsibilities, including, without limitation, an increase in the overall number of Bus Shelters and Automatic Public Toilets that the Company may install, maintain, and operate, and the modification of certain revenue requirements applicable to the Company.
