### NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT

**No. 1: IN THE MATTER** of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to utilize a different procedure, to enter into an amendment to the existing Concession Agreement between NYPD and Regent Catering Inc. ("Vendor") for the provision of Snack Bar/ Cafeteria services at the NYPD's Police Academy in College Point, Queens. The amendment extends the 2nd Renewal Agreement for this Concession for two years. The period covered by the 2 Year Amendment/ Extension will start on December 8, 2023 and run through December 7, 2025.

**No. 2: IN THE MATTER** of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to utilize a different procedure, to negotiate a Sole Source License Agreement ("Agreement") with the selected offeror Statue Cruises, LLC for the operation and maintenance of a commercial ferry service for the purpose of embarking and discharging passengers on a regular schedule between The Battery, Liberty Island, and Ellis Island, and for the purpose of embarking and discharging passengers of vessels on sightseeing cruises and other ferry operations, which may include but are not limited to day and night charters of vessels, owned, operated or chartered by the selected offeror Statue Cruises, LLC at landing slips and adjacent walkways located in The Battery, Manhattan.
