Environmental Review Training

Martha Kenton (DSS) announced that HUD will host two Environmental Review Trainings for CoC funded organizations in New York City. Trainings will be held at the HUD Field Office, 26 Federal Plaza, Room 36-108, on the following dates:

- July 11th 10am-12pm; register by July 5th
- August 2nd 1-3pm; register by July 26th

If you plan to attend this training, you *must* register beforehand, as security at the HUD Field Office needs a list of everyone that will be in attendance. All CoC funded PSH, RRH, TH-RRH, and TH projects are required to complete Environmental Reviews. HMIS Update

Michael Brydges (DSS) announced that the HIC-PIT and SPM were successfully submitted to HUD. HUD has released new data standards that all CoC funded projects must adhere to. Foothold will host a webinar on Monday, June 24th to give a debrief on the new data standards. This webinar will be recorded and will be available afterwards for those that are unable to attend. Michael also reminded those in attendance that HUD wants to see every program in HMIS.

Motion- RRH Rental Assistance

The Steering Committee considered a motion to amend the CoC RRH Written Standards to allow CoC Rapid Rehousing grantees to taper down rental assistance. This motion was made by Joey Lopez, seconded by Cameron Craig, and passed by unanimous voice vote.

2019 NOFA

Martha Kenton (DSS) gave the following updates on the 2019 NOFA:

- The NOFA has not been published yet, but the CoC will send out an announcement when it is released
- A special edition NOFA newsletter with reminders and tips to prepare was sent out last week.
- Please check and make sure that your E-SNAPS log in is active, and that you have at least two people in your organization that can access the system
- We expect for the NOFA renewal process to remain relatively unchanged. Once the NOFA is released, we will provide renewal training.
- If you plan to voluntarily reallocate any portion of your CoC contract, you *must* notify the CoC Co-Chairs of your intent to do so.
- For those projects that were contacted as potentially falling into Tier II, the CoC recommends that you take a close look at ways to improve performance.

 - There will be a separate meeting for any providers that plan to apply for a DV specific project. This meeting will be held in partnership with the Mayor’s Office to End Domestic and Gender-Based Violence.
 - The deadline for submission is May 31st, 2019. This is contingent on a NOFA release by the end of next week. The deadline will be adjusted, as needed, based on the date of release.
 - There are separate RFPs for the following component types: PSH, RRH, TH-RRH.
 - A cost framework is included for the RRH RFP.
 - Projects applying for DV funds will respond to the same RFP. There is no separate RFP for DV projects.

Highlights from the presentation include the creation of a CoC Advisory Council, a restructure of the Steering Committee to create a more action oriented group, the expansion of standing committees, and creation of quarterly CoC grant monitoring & technical assistance meetings.
