



CoC-Funded Rapid Re-housing for Youth & Young Adults

CoC-funded Rapid Re-housing (RRH) is a pathway to permanent housing for youth and young adults experiencing homelessness in New York City. Rapid Re-housing is a Housing First intervention designed to support households to quickly exit homelessness and establish a foundation for long-term permanent housing success.



Core Components of Rapid Rehousing

1 Housing Identification

Assistance in identifying and securing housing (RRH clients sign a 12-month lease in their own name)

2 Rental and Move-in Assistance

Time-limited rental assistance (typically a maximum of 24 months)

3 Case Management

Client-driven and focused on long-term housing stability



Eligibility

Age 18 to 24

AND

Experiencing homelessness
(HUD Category 1)

OR

At imminent risk of homelessness (HUD Category 2)



How to Qualify

Homeless services providers will work with interested individuals to complete the CAPS survey. If potential RRH eligibility is determined, the case worker will be contacted by the Department for Youth and Community Development (DYCD) and referred to a RRH provider for intake and screening.
