- Safety Officers on grounds
- RTM would like to mirror their standards of quality care for residents
- Pilot a program across all 5 boros in every complex

NYCHA

- Approximately 302 high- & low-rise buildings
- PSA's to assist
- How will NYCHA assist in developing a similar program?

What could NYPD do for residents?



Keep	Keep community safer when shootings arise
Respond	Respond to calls quicker
Increase	Increase foot patrol in and around the buildings
Respond	Respond to noise complaints more effectively
Be	Be honest with residents and tell them what resources are available to them

Cameras & Lights

Cameras should be added to all developments, stairwells, outside perimeter of buildings

NYCHA cameras are not monitored

Poor Lighting



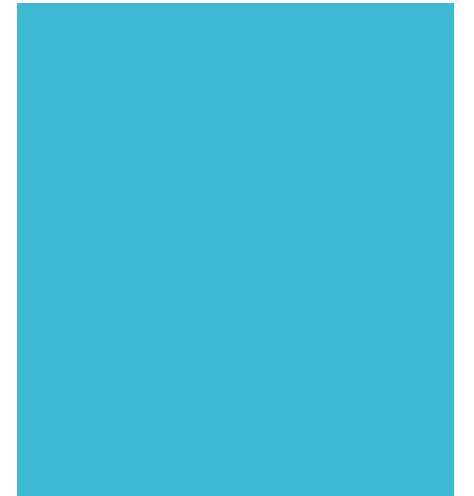
Shootings & Fatalities

Create and post Safety Officer Positions to hire

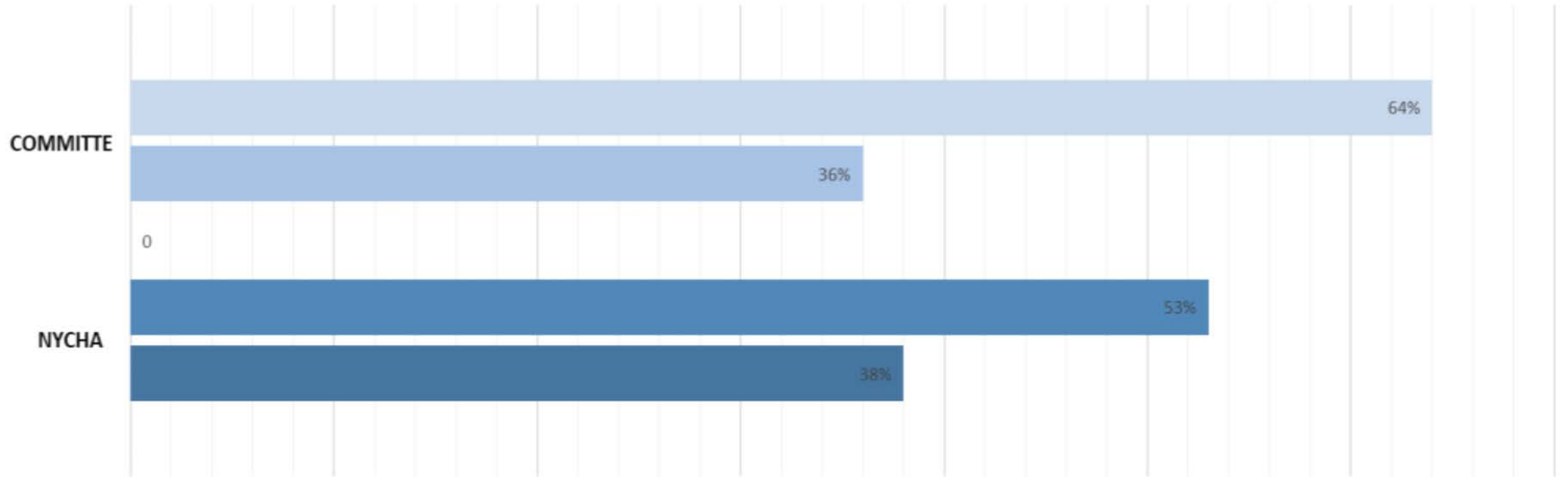
Cannot live in NYCHA/Conflict of interest
