LIEUTENANT FEDERICO NARVAEZ

Lieutenant Federico Narvaez was shot and killed as he attempted to arrest a male who was stalking his ex-girlfriend's daughter.

On Friday, October 18, 1996, Lieutenant Narvaez and his driver were on patrol in the Flatbush section of Brooklyn. At about 7:00 pm, they were flagged down by a woman in front of 191 East 17th Street who told them she was being stalked by her mother's ex-boyfriend.

When Lieutenant Narvaez and his driver exited their vehicle and approached, the perpetrator drew a handgun and fired, striking Lieutenant Narvaez in the face.

The suspect then fled on foot, with Lieutenant Narvaez's driver in pursuit and exchanging gunfire with the perpetrator. The perpetrator ran to the front of 1713 Beverly Road, and attempted to enter the building. He was unable to get in, and was then shot and killed in an exchange of gunfire with several responding officers.

Lieutenant Narvaez was taken to Kings County Hospital, where he died from his wound.

Lieutenant Narvaez was 40 years old and had served with the New York City Police Department for 17 years. He is survived by his wife, Marilyn; his parents, Federico and Antonia; his brothers Daniel and David; his sister, Ruth and his daughter, Katrina who in 2013 joined the New York City Police Department as a Police Officer.
