MR. FIDEL DEL VALLE, ESQ., CHAIR, OATH:
Good morning, folks. Welcome to our first fall
meeting. Is there a motion to adopt the minutes
of the August 24th meeting? They're adopted.

MR. RUSSELL PECUNIES, ESQ., DEPT. OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION: Abstain since I wasn't here.

MR. DEL VALLE: With one abstention, they're adopted. DEP has some exciting cease and desist orders.

MR. PECUNIES: Okay. Good morning. My name is Russell Pecunies and I'm with the Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Legal Affairs. This month, DEP is requesting that the Board issue one cease and desist order under the Sewer Code. This is for a Domino's Pizza located at 241 Rockaway Parkway in Brooklyn. And this location has been ordered based on an inspection that was conducted in June of last year to open its grease interceptors for inspection. Subsequently, DEP issued a

1 September 28, 2017 2 Commissioner's Order requiring the respondent to install and maintain grease interceptors for a 3 4 sink and for a floor drain. Based on 5 respondent's failure to comply with that order, a series of summonses were issued which still did 6 7 not result in the Domino's installing the 8 required grease interceptors. Finally, the 9 respondent was ordered to appear for a mandatory 10 compliance meeting on June 21st of this year, 11 which they failed to appear for. And based on 12 the continuing noncompliance with the Sewer Code, 13 DEP is asking the Board to issue an order to 14 cease and desist. 15 MR. DEL VALLE: Any questions? Motion? 16 Approved. 17 MR. PECUNIES: And addition--18 MR. DEL VALLE: Sounds like they're 19 endangering their franchise with Domino's. 20 MR. PECUNIES: I don't know if those are 21 franchises or corporate, but it's issued to 2.2 Domino's Pizza as an LLC so. 23 MR. DEL VALLE: Hmm. 24 MR. PECUNIES: Additionally, DEP has, I

believe, it's 27 requests for cease and desist orders for failing to install backflow prevention devices. In each of these cases, the building owner has been ordered after a DEP inspection of the premises to install backflow prevention devices on the water services. When they failed to do so, they've been issued with a summons, which has been upheld or defaulted on. In each of these cases, the respondents are still not in compliance and therefore, in each of these cases, the Department is requesting that the Board issue an order to cease and desist.

MR. PECUNIES: Alright. Thank you.

MR. DEL VALLE: Thank you. Kelly?

Kelly will go over the requests for pre-sealing reports.

officers recommend no sealing or other action based on the compliance that the respondents presented at the hearings. We have two sewer cases and for both of these cases, the hearing officers have agreed with DEP's recommendation that the proceedings be discontinued based on the fact that the respondents have complied with the order. And we have one Noise Code case. And in this case, the hearing officer recommends no further action and that the proceeding be discontinued based on respondent's evidence that the cited air conditioning equipment has been removed and replaced. And that's it.
