The <u>2022 Consolidated Plan Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER)</u> is the City of New York's report on the uses of funds from the four U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Community Planning and Development (HUD-CPD) formula entitlement grant programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME); Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG); and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA). The performance is based on funds received, commitments and accomplishments made on the use of these funds during the 2022 program year, January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2022.

In 2022, the City received \$304,212,902 in entitlement funds for the four HUD formula grant programs: \$166,259,543 for CDBG; \$81,327,120 for HOME; \$41,777,058 for HOPWA; and \$14,849,181 for ESG.

The Mayor's Office of Operations is announcing a 15-day public comment period that will begin **June 13, 2023** and continue through **June 28, 2023**. The City's 2022 CAPER can be accessed at the Mayor's Office of Operations website.
