3.0 SOCIOECONOMIC CONDITIONS

3.1 Introduction

This chapter describes the effects that the proposed project may have on socioeconomic conditions. The proposed project would not result in the displacement of residences or businesses or result in a new development substantially different from the existing health care and hospital community facility uses, residential uses, and recreational uses within a ½ mile of the site. The proposed project would not result in impacts to socioeconomic conditions. Therefore, an analysis of Socioeconomic conditions is not required in the EIS.

3.2 Benefits to Socioeconomic Conditions

The proposed project would not result in the displacement of residences or businesses or result in a new development substantially different from existing uses. The proposed project would not result in impacts to socioeconomic conditions. Therefore, an analysis of Socioeconomic conditions is not required. The proposed project would create a significant new patient care facility and improve existing patient care to those needing specialized orthopedic surgery, and itwould generate significant beneficial employment and fiscal benefits for New York City and State.
