

In the early morning hours on FRIDAY, MAY 5TH, the NYC Department of Transportation Division of Bridges will close the single eastbound lane of the Roosevelt Avenue Bridge between 126th Street and Janet Place from 12:01 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Lanes on the bridge have already been reduced due to Stage 1 construction. As a result, only one lane of westbound traffic will be allowed during this period. Please see the back of this page for a detour map. The closure is necessary to perform maintenance of the construction area and pothole repair.






